



Assisted Living

- ▶ Assisted Living provides an effective way to allow seniors to live in their apartments while on-site supports and assistance are available at any time.

There is **NO CHARGE** for this service. It is funded by the **Ministry of Health and Long-Term Care and the City of Toronto**



How it works

- ▶ Personal Support Workers (PSWs) provide personal care, homemaking and emergency response 24/7 to residents that are currently living in our selected seniors apartment buildings located throughout the Etobicoke and Brampton areas.
- ▶ The residents of our Assisted Living locations maintain a strong sense of community with the people in their building.
- ▶ CANES' Staff have an on-site office within the Assisted Living building offering residents 24 hour service 7 days a week, day or night.

Who can use this service?

- ▶ Any senior or adult with a physical disability living in our designated buildings throughout Etobicoke, Brampton and Vaughan.
- ▶ After an assessment interview, the client is given a schedule of visits by Personal Support Workers, subject to the clients needs and staff/funding availability.
